Covers the variety of ways to make a family, the adoption process, and the importance of realizing that both the adoptive parents and the birth parents love their children. Ages 6-7.

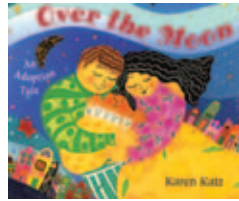


## *I Love You Like Crazy Cakes*

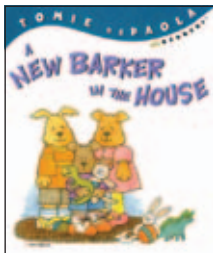
This story of a woman who travels to China to adopt a baby girl is a celebration of the love and joy a baby brings into the home. Ages 2-4.
