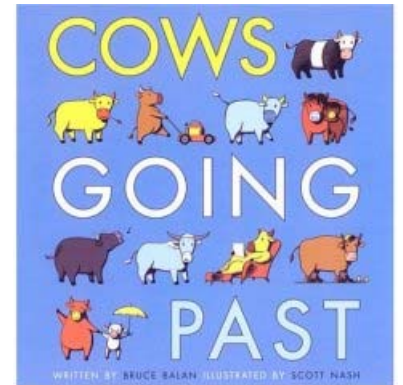


Cows Going Past by Bruce Balan, illustrated by Scott Nash

Here are some ways to use this book with your child:

- Notice the cover. Who's there? What are those cows doing? After reading it through once, ask the child where do we go when we travel?
- Find the title page. What clue does it give you to the rest of the story? Do you ever see a cow holding a sign? Maybe this will be a silly story!
- 1. Ask your child to point to the cows every time you say the word "cow".
- After reading the book several times, have children find other items around them that correspond to the same color as the cow. For example: A white cow in a brown field. Can you find something else in this room that is white?
