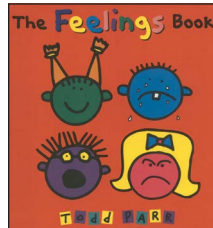

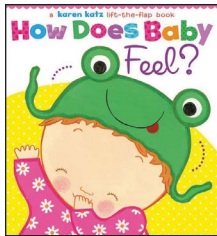

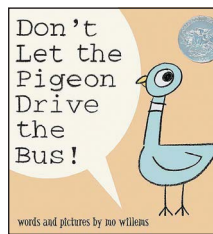

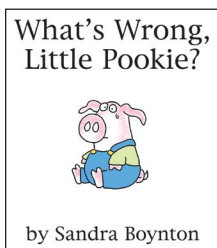
Don't Let the Pigeon Drive the Bus

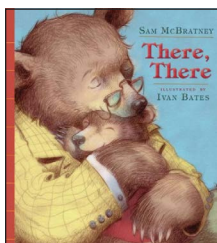

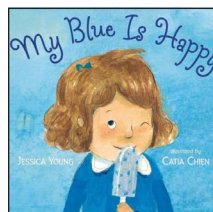
