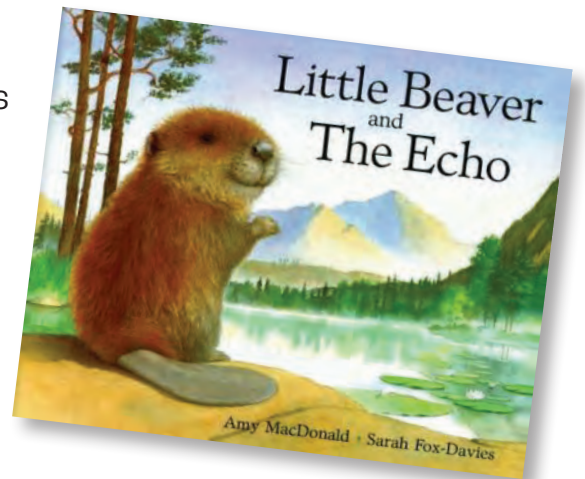


# 10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK

## Little Beaver and the Echo

by Amy MacDonald, illustrated by Sarah Fox-Davies

- 1 **PLAN** a pretend canoe trip to somewhere exciting
- 2 **CREATE** a hopscotch board that looks like lily pads
- 3 **PRETEND** to cry using silly sounds
- 4 **DRAW** a picture with a pond, canoe, and animals
- 5 **ACT** out the story using stuffed animals
- 6 **DO** something nice for a friend
- 7 **SING** *Row, Row, Row Your Boat* together
- 8 **PLAY** an echo game by repeating what your child says
- 9 **RETELL** the story with your child using the illustrations
- 10 **TALK** about feeling sad and what makes you feel better



### FIVE WAYS TO DISCOVER ANY BOOK WITH A CHILD

1

Talk about what the book makes you both think or feel.

2

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

3

Act out parts of the story.

4

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.

5

Retell the story using the illustrations.
