
## **10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK**

## Hooray for Birds!

- **NAME** all the colors you see throughout the book
- MAKE a nest with blankets and pillows
- TALK together about what birds eat
- **TAKE** a walk to look and listen for birds
- **READ** about the lifecycle of birds
- **CREATE** a new bird sound
- **COUNT** the birds on the end pages together
- LOOK outside for insects and other things that fly
- **PRETEND** to be a bird: fly, peck, scratch, hop, swim, etc.
- **LEARN** more about one of the birds in the book (flamingoes, starlings, woodpecker, etc.)



## **FIVE WAYS TO DISCOVER ANY BOOK WITH A CHILD**



Talk about what the book makes you both think or feel.

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

Act out parts of the story.

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.



Retell the story using the illustrations.
