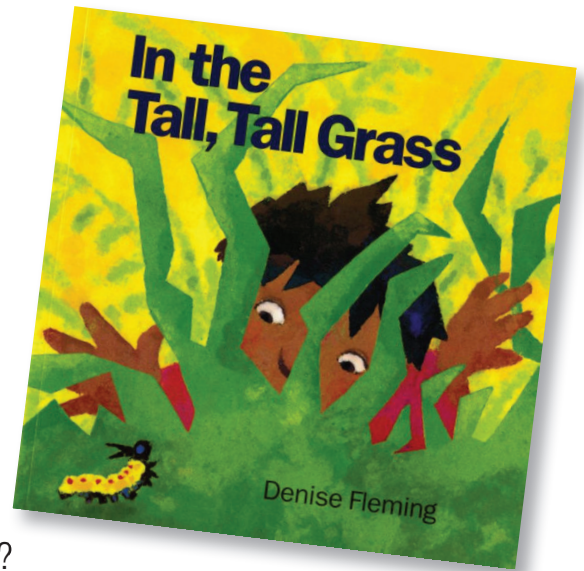


10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK

In the Tall, Tall Grass

- 1 **PLAY** I spy outside
- 2 **LEARN** more about the life cycle of a caterpillar
- 3 **FIND** the caterpillar on each page
- 4 **TAKE** a nature walk to search for bugs
- 5 **CREATE** some rhyming sentences together
- 6 **RETELL** the story: where was the caterpillar going?
- 7 **DRAW** a picture of what you saw during your nature walk
- 8 **TALK** about size: why is the caterpillar large or small on a different page?
- 9 **PRETEND** your pointer finger is a caterpillar and go on an adventure around your home
- 10 **USE** some of the unique words in the book when talking with your child (tug, dart, glide)



FIVE WAYS TO DISCOVER ANY BOOK WITH A CHILD

Talk about what the book makes you both think or feel.

2

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

3

Act out parts of the story.

4

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.

5

Retell the story using the illustrations.
