

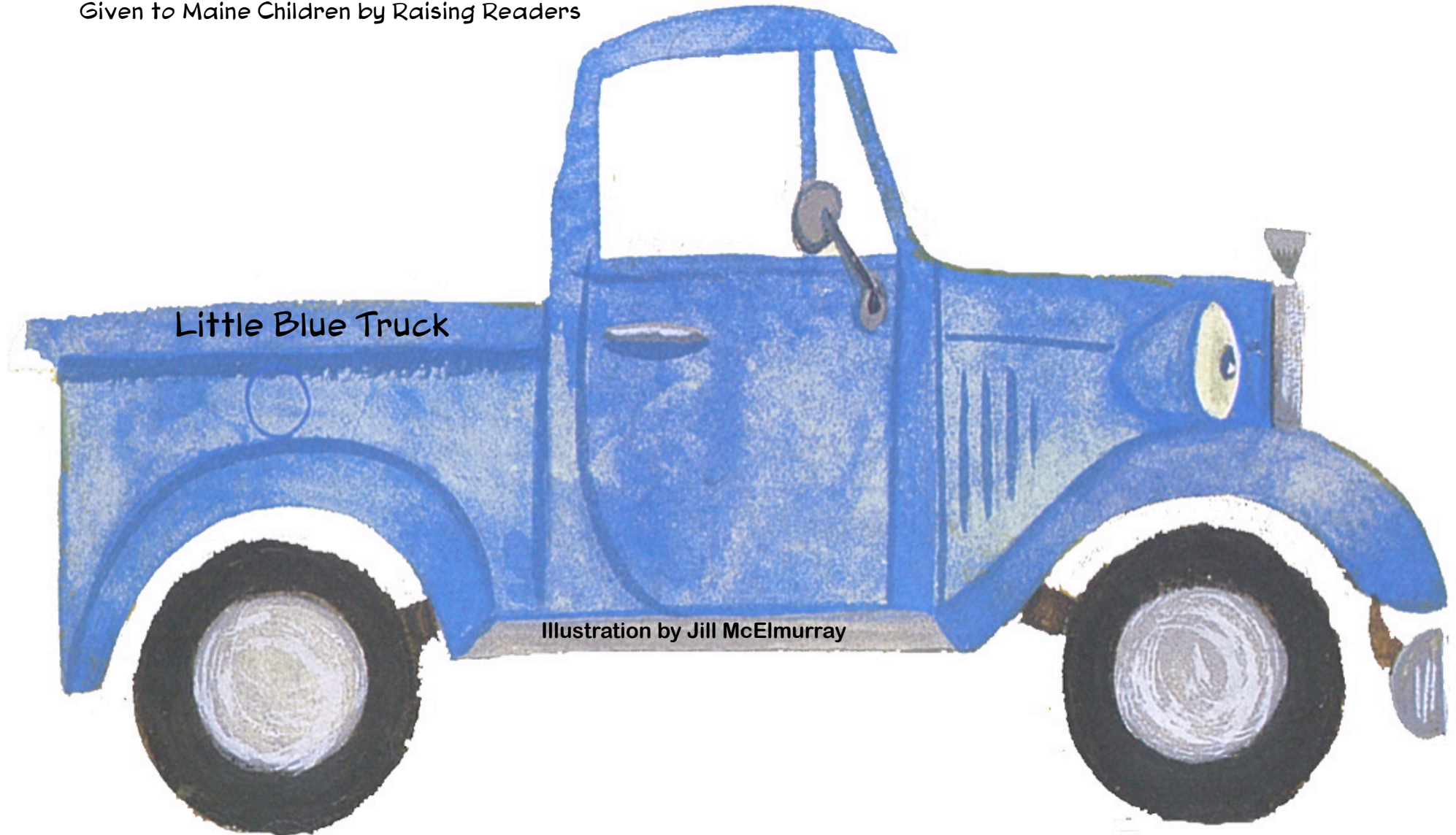

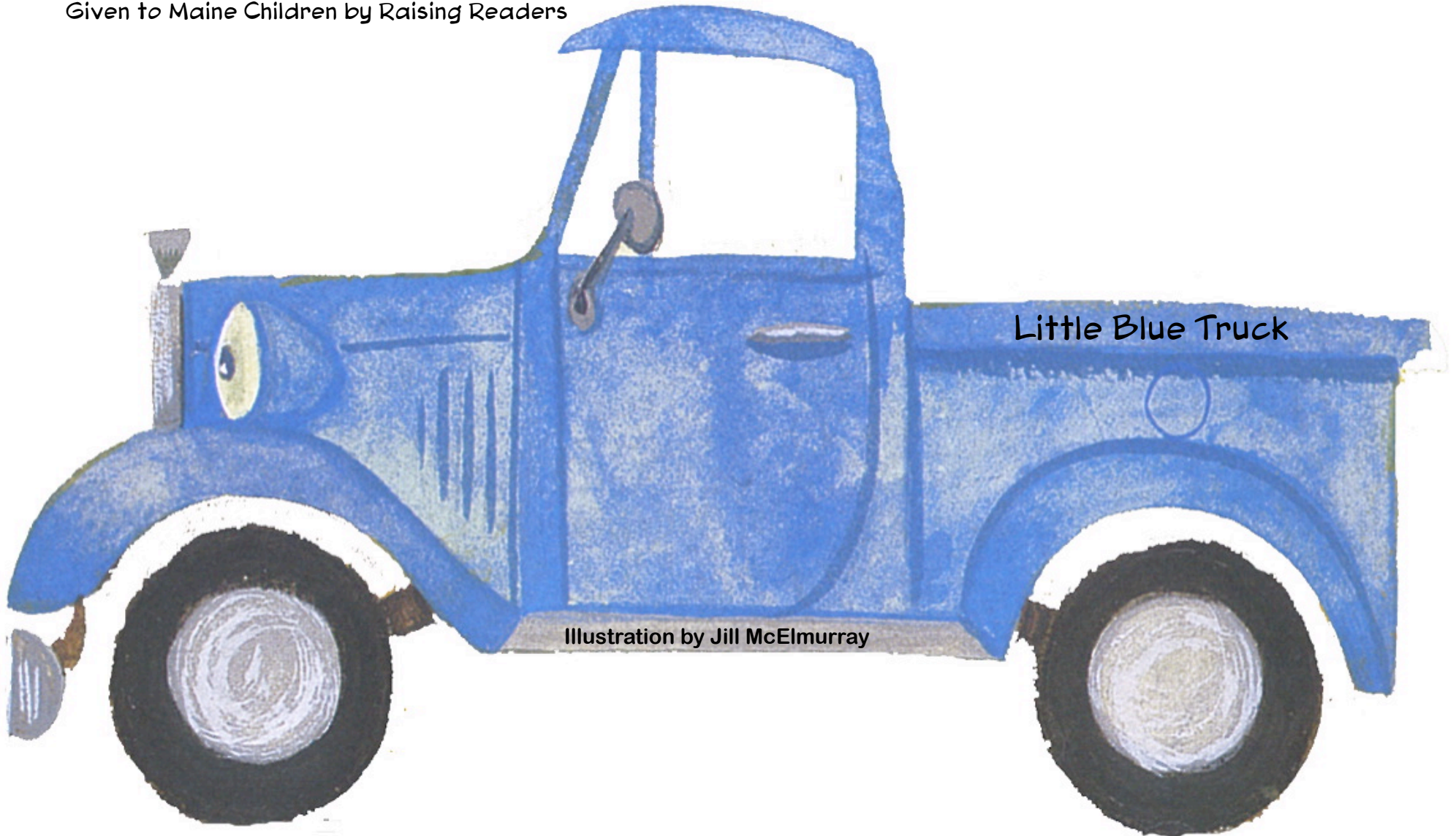

STEP 3 :

- Find an empty cereal box and lay it on its side

- Paste or tape a truck to either side of the box. Make sure the trucks both point the same direction.

- With a pen, poke a hole in the skinny end of the cereal box. Do this at top of the box on the end where the truck faces.

- Find string, yarn, or an old shoelace about 1 foot long and knot it in the hole you just made. Now your child should be able to pull the Little Blue Truck along the floor and act out the story.

-Optional: You can cut out the top of the box so the truck bed is open to hold toy farm animals.
