

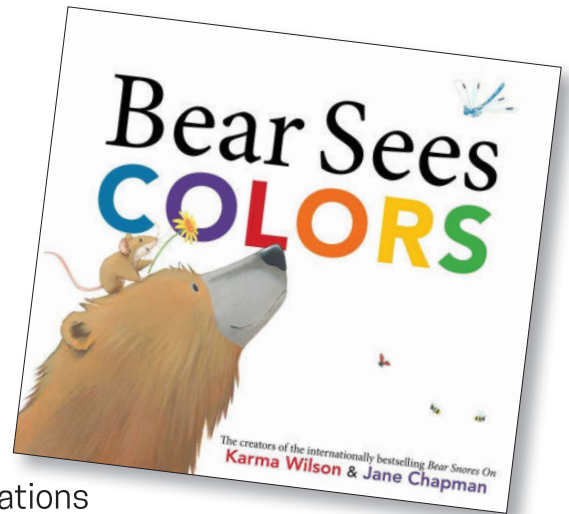
10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK

Bear Sees COLORS

- 1 SHARE a real or pretend picnic with colorful foods
- 2 PLAY “I Spy” with colors around you and your child
- 3 MAKE up a silly song with lots of rhyming words
- 4 DRAW a rainbow with crayons or chalk
- 5 TELL another story about Bear using just the illustrations
- 6 TALK about colors not in the book (Purple, black, orange, etc.)
- 7 LEARN about the animals in the book by reading about them
- 8 SORT toys or household objects together according to color
- 9 ASK your child what color s/he wants to wear when getting dressed
- 10 POINT to the big letters of each color in the book and spell them out

Example: “Red. R-E-D. That spells red.”



FIVE WAYS TO DISCOVER ANY BOOK WITH A CHILD

1

Talk about what the book makes you both think or feel.

2

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

3

Act out parts of the story.

4

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.

5

Retell the story using the illustrations.
