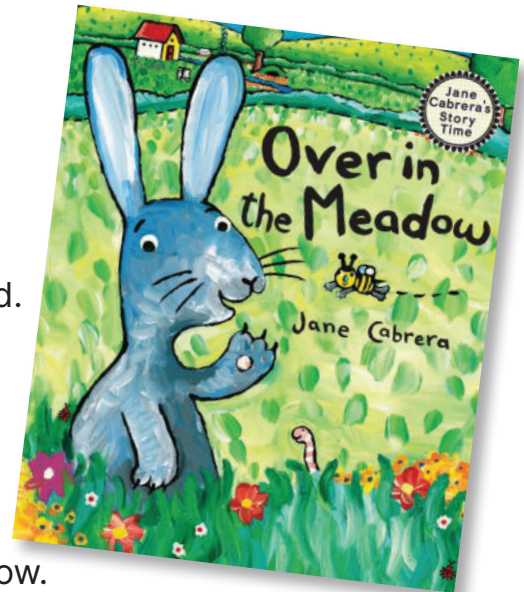


10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK

- 1 **DRAW** your favorite animal from the book.
- 2 **USE** your fingers to show each number you read.
- 3 **ACT** like the animal on each page.
- 4 **FIND** all the animals on the next to last page.
- 5 **NAME** the colors on the inside covers.
- 6 **CREATE** a counting rhyme for an animal you know.
- 7 **POINT** to each animal and count along as you read.
- 8 **ASK** what the animal is before you read each page.
- 9 **WALK** around your neighborhood. What animals do you see?
- 10 **COUNT** how many of one thing you can find in your house.

Talk about what the book makes you both think or feel.

2

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

3

Act out parts of the story.

4

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.

5

Retell the story using the illustrations.
