
10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK

Cows in the Kitchen

- SING the book using the tune "Skip to My Lou"
- **POINT** out different colors throughout the book
- **SEARCH** for the white mouse on each page
- SHARE sounds for the mouse and dog
- **IMITATE** the sounds of each animal
- **COUNT** the animals on each page
- **SCRIBBLE** together with your child
- LET your child trace the dotted lines to follow what is moving
- STUDY the details of the pictures and talk about what you see
- TALK about where each of the animals should be on the farm (barn, pond, sty, coop, field)



FIVE WAYS TO DISCOVER ANY BOOK WITH A CHILD

Talk about what the book makes you both think or feel.

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

Act out parts of the story.

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.

Retell the story using the illustrations.
