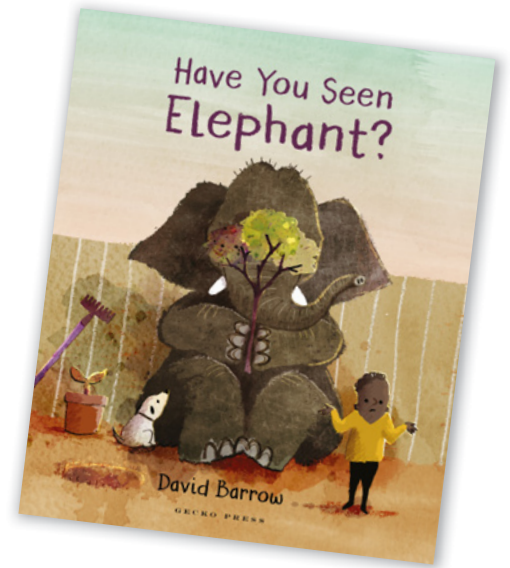


10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK

Have You Seen Elephant?

1. **Play** hide & seek.

3. **Count** to ten using your fingers.
4. **Research** elephants and learn one new fact about them.
5. **Think** of places that the turtle should hide.
6. **Draw** elephant hiding in a new spot.
7. **Sing** “Old MacDonald Had a Farm” and add in an elephant.
8. **Pretend** you are an elephant.
9. **Make** an elephant mask from a paper plate or paper. Retell the story starring you as the elephant.
10. **Try** to think of a way an elephant could really hide. Where could they go?

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

Act out parts of the story.

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.

5

Retell the story using the illustrations.
